What will your day look like? Unlike coming to KLKP as a student, your training will have a different focus.

Part of each day will be spent in

- Learning and practising planning and teaching techniques, strategies and skills.
- observing a wide variety of teachers (various instruments)
- Teaching small groups and receiving targeted feedback
- Working alongside camp teachers and co-leading activities.
- developing your teaching philosophy and toolbox
- Lots of playing, jamming/ learning and KLKP fun.

### How do I apply? What are the requirements? What is the cost?

1. Fill out the attached application form. Only 4 interns will be accepted per week.
2. Cost: \$705 total: all meals and shared bunkhouse accommodations.
  - a. Note: partial cost of program is sponsored by KLKP: \$105 pp
  - b. So YOUR cost is a flat \$600.
